Day 1: 27.MAY.25 ARRIVAL IN ENTEBBE

On arrival at Entebbe International Airport in Uganda and after finalizing the formalities, you shall be welcomed by your guide, who will then drive you to your hotel for an overnight.

Transit time: Approx. 10 mins, 7 kms

Day 2: 28.MAY.25 DRIVE TO MURCHISON FALLS NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast you shall start your tour. Driving through Kampala, you proceed to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary. Here you shall have a walking Safari to the Southern Park to trek White Rhinos that have been re-introduced in Uganda. In the afternoon you will drive to the legendary Murchison Falls, from which the National park derives its name.

Day 3: 29.MAY.25 GAME DRIVE AND LAUNCH CRUISE ON THE RIVER NILE

After an early breakfast, you will go for a game drive. This is a beautiful drive across savannah, Borassus Palm Forest and grassland down to Lake Albert where the Albert Nile heads north. Drive in the open African savanna in search for Lions, Leopard, Hyena, Buffalo, Elephant, Jackson Hartebeest. Oribi, Waterbucks, Uganda Kobs, and enjoy spotting various Bird ecies such as the Secretary Bird, Black Chested Snake Eagle, Tawny and Marshal Eagles Carmine and Swallow Tailed Bee-Eaters and many more. In the afternoon, go for a boat ride up the Nile, to Murchison falls, whence the park derives its name. Enjoy these spectacular falls by hiking to the top of the falls.

Day 4: 30.MAY.25 DAY AT LEISURE

After an early breakfast, choose to spend the day at leisure otherwise you will visit the top of the falls and have a spectacular view of the falls from above.

Day 5: 31.MAY.25 FLY TO KIBALE FOREST NATIONAL PARK

Today you will fly from Murchison Falls National Park to Kasese Airstrip, upon arrival you will meet with your guide and then transfer to Kibale National Park, along the way you will pass many tea plantations. Kibale National Park is a national park in Western Uganda, protecting moist evergreen rain forest. It is 766 square kilometers in size and is located between 1,100 meters to 1,600 meters in elevation. Despite encompassing primarily moist evergreen forest, it contains a diverse array of landscapes. Arrive later at your lodge for an overnight.

Day 6: 01 JUNE .25 CHIMPANZEE HABITUATION EXPERIENCE, BIGODI SWAMP WALK

Today you will experience Chimpanzee Habituation in Kibale Forest National Park. You will arrive at the park Headquarters at 6:30 am for briefing. Led by an experienced Ranger Guide, You will start off into the forest to find the Chimps as they awake from their Nests. Thereafter you will follow a Chimpanzee family, observing how they hunt, feed, Mate, Play with the young, interact and rest. You will get to learn to identify them as individuals by their markings, scars and other unique features that make them stand apart from rest. There are 4950 chimpanzees within Uganda; Kibale Forest alone has the most with almost 1500 Chimpanzees. In the afternoon after tracking, you have the opportunity to take a guided walk through the swamps of Bigodi or in a nearby village.

Day 7: 02 JUNE.25 HIKE TO THE TOP OF THE WORLD, DRIVE TO QUEEN ELIZABETH NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast you will explore the crater Lakes with a hike to the Top of the world for a better view of most of the lakes, proceed to Tooro Kingdom and visit the Kings Palace. Thereafter drive to the world-famous Queen Elizabeth National Park, crossing the equator along the way. Named after her Majesty the Queen of England, it is Uganda's most popular and most scenic game reserves. It stretches from the crater-dotted foothills of the Rwenzori range in the north, along the shores of Lake Edward to the remote Ishasha River in the south, incorporating a wide variety of habitats that range from savanna and wetlands and lowland forest. You shall have an evening game drive in the park

Transit time: Approx. 2-3 hours, 120 km

Day 8: 03.JUNE.25 GAME DRIVE, BOAT RIDE ON THE KAZINGA CHANNEL

Have an Early Morning Game Drive. There are over 100 mammal species that include Lions, Hippos, Buffaloes, Leopard, Spotted Hyena, Elephants and the elusive Giant Forest Hog in this park. The Primates include Chimps, Black and White Colobus Monkeys, Blue, Black faced Red Colobus, and Red tailed monkeys and Olive Baboons. In the afternoon, you shall have a boat ride on Kazinga Channel. Queen Elizabeth boasts one of the highest bio diversity ratings of any game park, from the open Savannah to Rain Forest, dense Papyrus Swamps and Crater Lakes to the vastness of Lake Edward.

Day 10: 05.JUNE.25 GAME DRIVE IN ISHASHA, DRIVE TO BWINDI NATIONAL PARK

Depart for Bwindi National park in the morning on your way; you will have a chance to have a game drive in Ishasha Sector where the tree climbing lions are found. You will have lunch at Ishasha Wilderness Camp then continue to the home of the mountain Gorillas. Of Uganda's forested parks, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park is best known for gorilla Tracking, but it also provides refuge to elephants, chimpanzees, monkeys and various small antelopes, as well as 23 bird species restricted to the Albertine.

Transit time: Approx. 2.5 hours, 119 km

Day 11: 06.JUNE.25 GORILLA TREKKING

This morning you will get up early and go for the gorilla trekking with a primate expert. Trekking the Mountain Gorilla is one of the most exciting wildlife experiences on earth. The trek will take between 2 and 6 hours, but is well worth the effort. You will be led by an experienced ranger who will tell you interesting facts about flora and fauna and the lifestyle of the Gorillas.

Day 12: 07.JUNE.25 DAY AT LEISURE

Today you may choose to spend the day at leisure or choose between optional activities such as an optional forest walk to the falls, optional visit to the ride for woman project an organization that takes care of women and children living with HIV by teaching them how to make crafts etc., or take a village walk to the local communities where you will visit a tea plantation, learn how tea is grown and cared for till the final product a cup of tea, then you will visit a local family with an African setting, learn more about their culture and beliefs, proceed to a banana brewing community to learn how local brew is made out of bananas.

Day 13: 08.JUNE.25 FLY BACK TO ENTEBBE AND DEPART

In the Afternoon, you will drive to Kihiki Airstrip and fly back to Entebbe enjoying the beautiful aerial view of south western Uganda, the hills and thick vegetation as well as the farming practiced by the locals. Afterwards you will arrive at the Airport and catch a flight back home.
